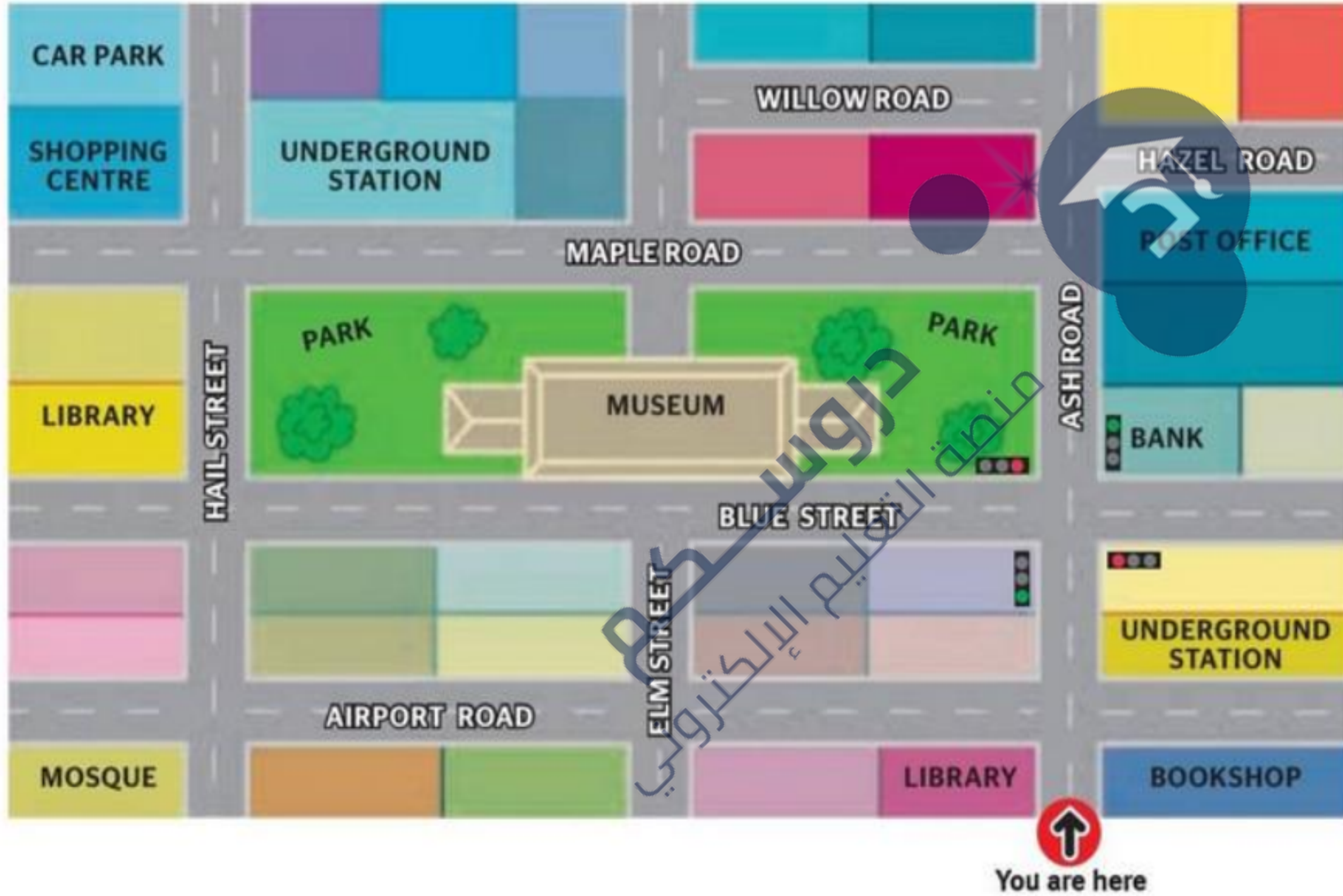

General rule	Most nouns are made plural by adding -s to the end of the singular form.		
Nouns ending in 's', 'x', 'z', 'ch', 'sh', 'ss'	Adding -es		Fez - Fezzes Gas - Gasses
Nouns ending in 'f' or 'fe'	Changing the ending to -ves .		Cuff - Cuffs Chef - Chefs Belief - Beliefs
Nouns ending in 'o'	1 Nouns that end in 'o' preceded by a vowel are made plural by adding -s .		
	2 Nouns that end in "o" preceded by a consonant are made plural by adding -es .		Piano - Pianos Photo - Photos Halo - Halos
Nouns ending in 'y'	1 When the 'y' follows a consonant, changing 'y' to 'i' and adding -es .		
	2 When the 'y' follows a vowel, the plural is formed by retaining the 'y' and adding -s .

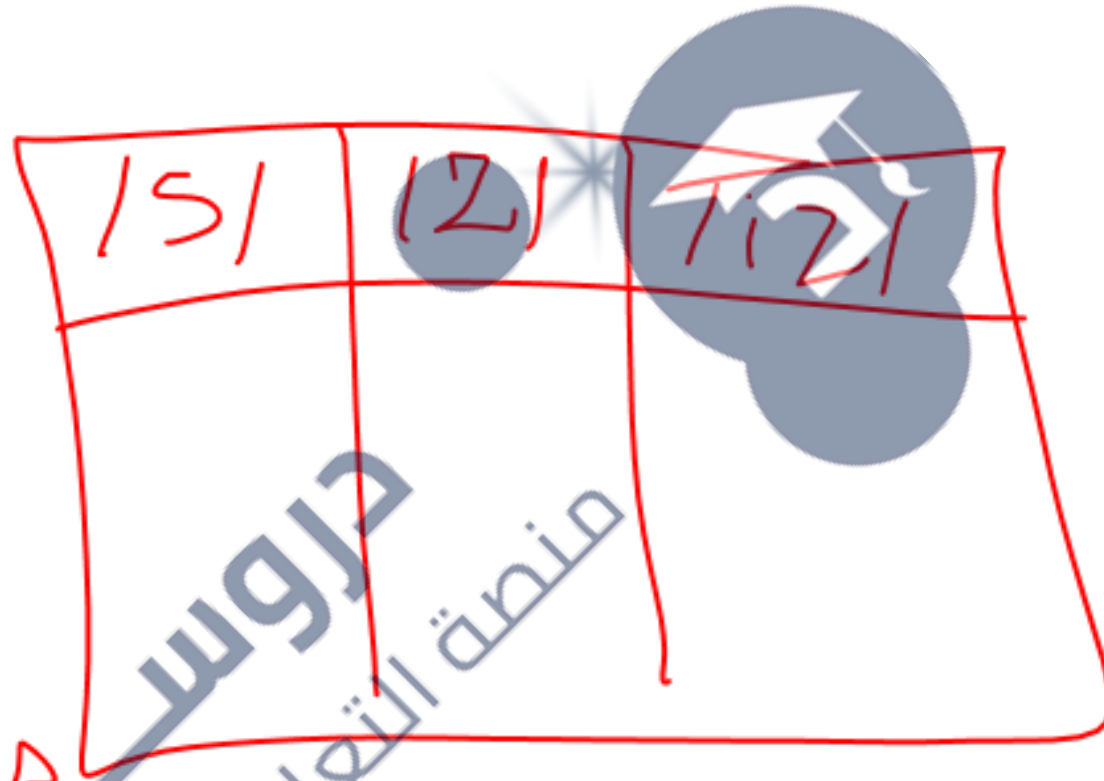
