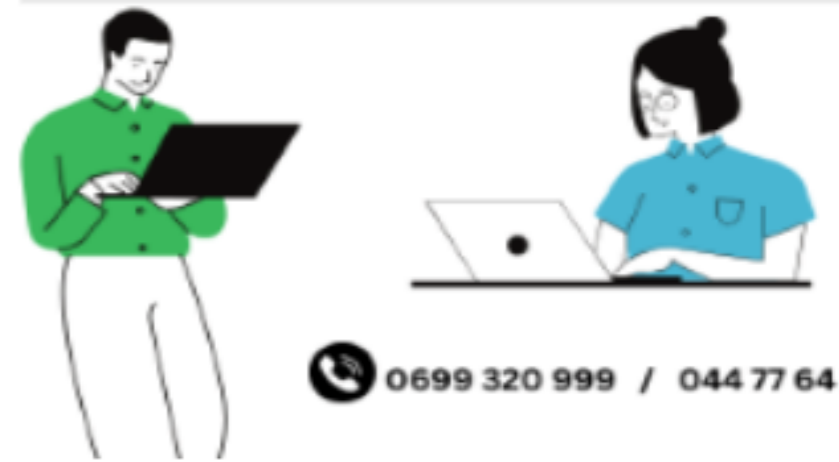

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

**Tourist guide:** Do you see that high tower at the end of the Houses of Parliament? Well, this is the clock tower, which tourists often call "Big Ben" when referring to London's most famous landmark. But that's wrong. It is the massive bell inside the clock tower that is correctly referred to as Big Ben. It is believed Big Ben was named after Sir Benjamin Hall, whose name is inscribed on the bell. Others say that the bell was named after the champion heavyweight boxer Ben Caunt (nicknamed "Big Ben") because it was the largest of its kind.

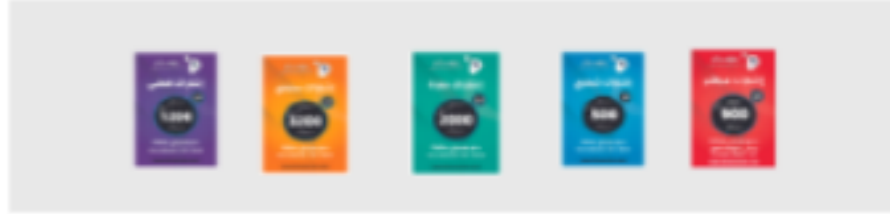
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### Tasks 8, 9 and 10: I listen to the tourist guide (Part 3)

**Tourist guide:** As for the clock itself, Edmund Beckett Denison worked with Edward Dent, a clockmaker, to design the clock which would become the Great Clock in the clock tower at the Palace of Westminster. Big Ben chimed for the first time on 11<sup>th</sup> July 1859. The bell's strikes were broadcast internationally by the BBC for the first time in 1932. Big Ben weighs 13.7 tons, stands 2.2 meters tall and has a diameter of 2.7 meters. The hammer weighs 200 kilos. The clock tower, which is 96 meters tall, looks spectacular at night when the four clock faces are illuminated.

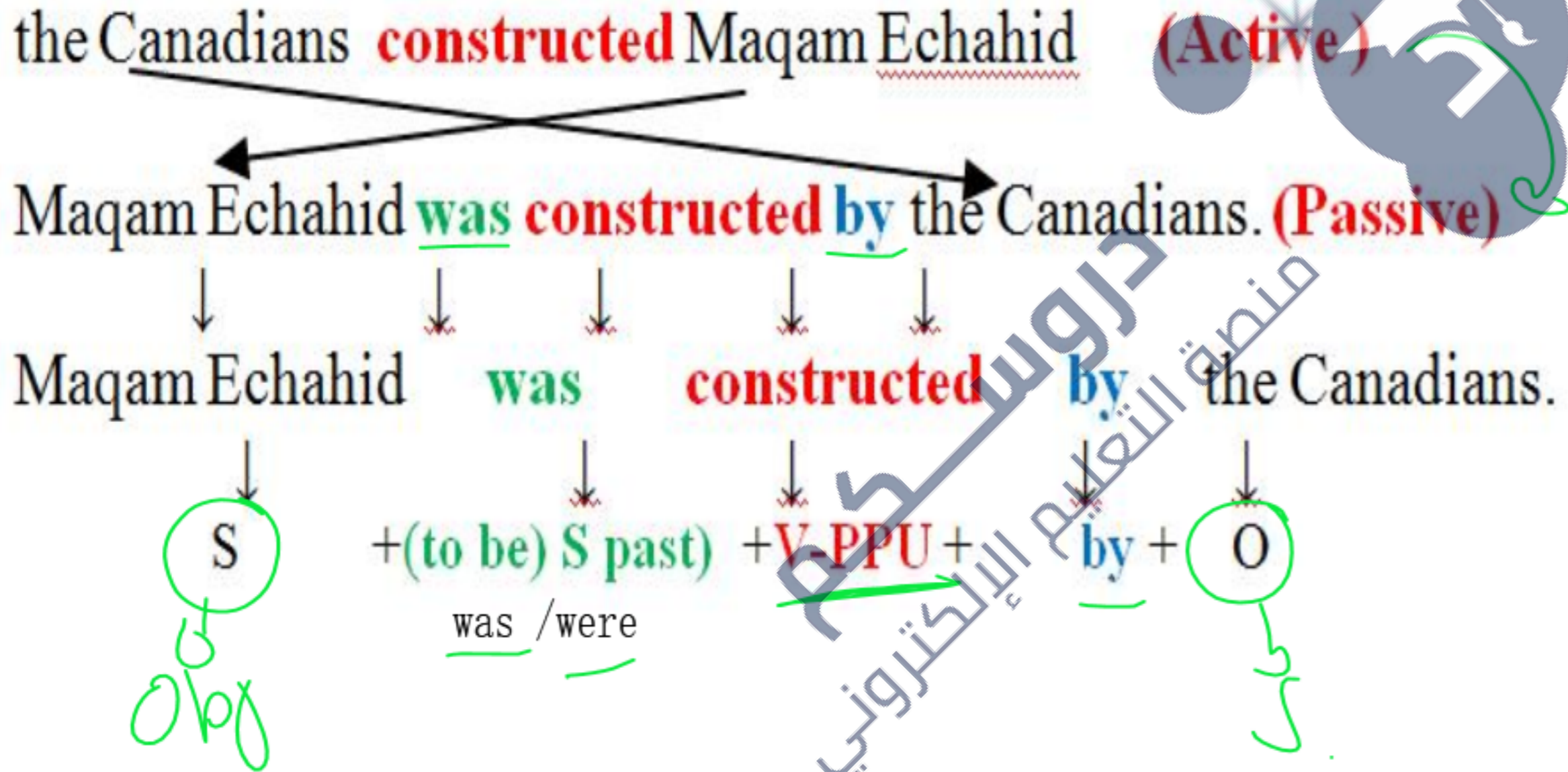
