The active and the passive forms (or voices) are two different ways of organizing the content of a sentence.

Examples:

Gustave Eiffel designed The Eiffel Tower

(Active)

Direct Object

Subject/ Does

Subject

The Eiffel Tower (was designed by Gustave Eiffel. (Passive)

Agent/ Doer

In the active form, the focus is on the subject or the "doer" of the action ("a fire"). The active form is the typical, usual form or structure of an English sentence:

"Subject + Verb + Direct Object"

In the passive form, the focus is on the person or the thing that the action was done to ("the Eiffel Tower").
