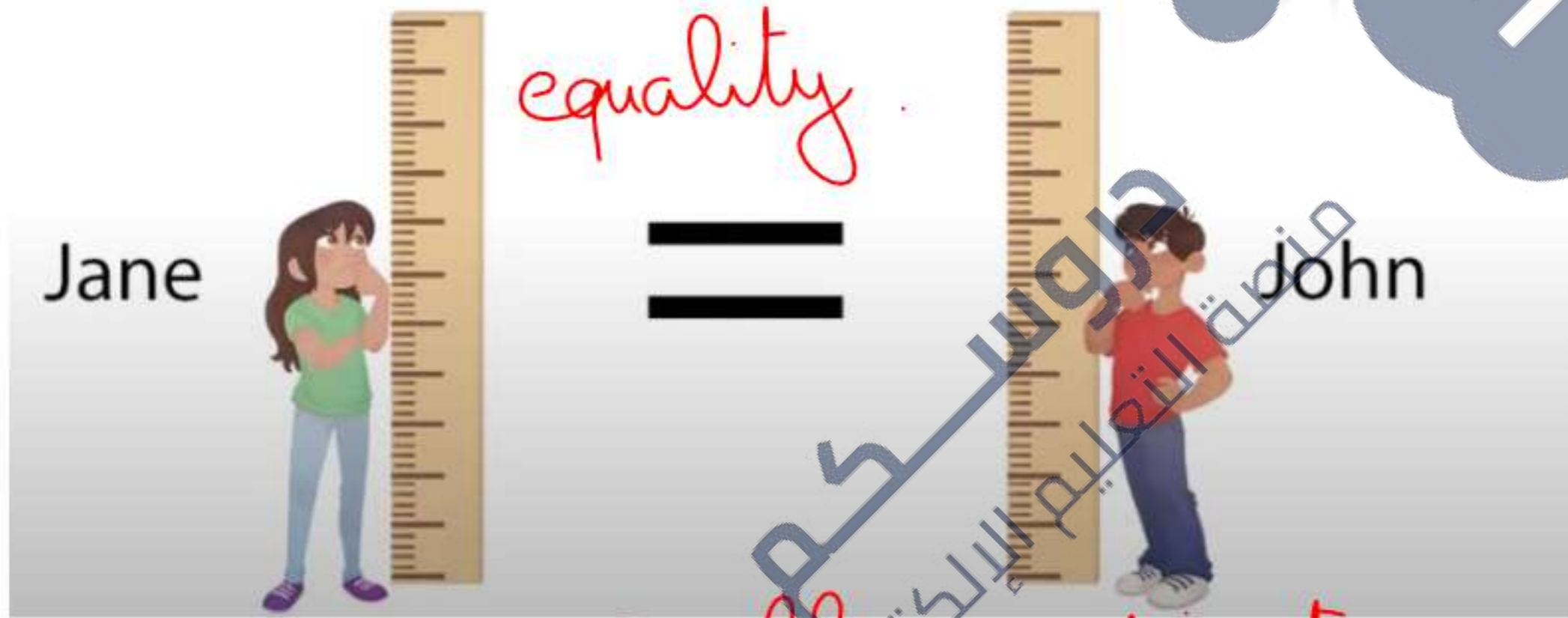

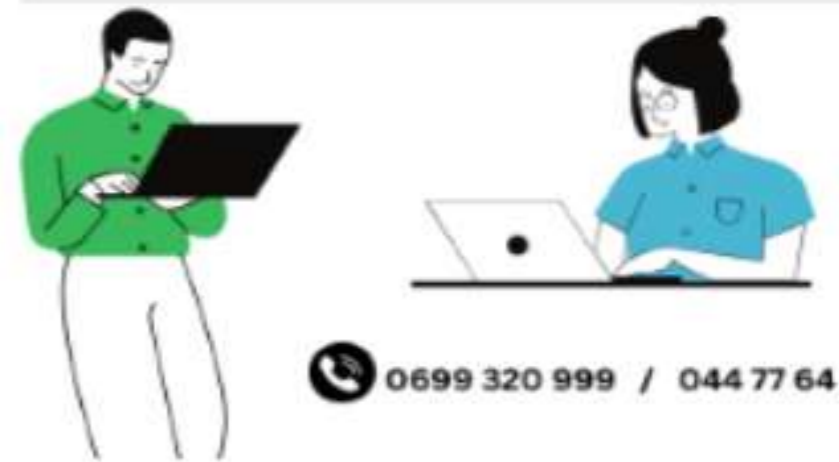

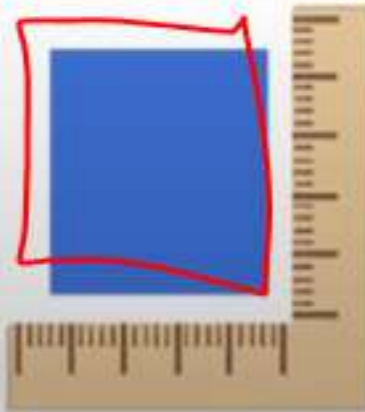

Example: - Pisa is as big as Malaga. (=)

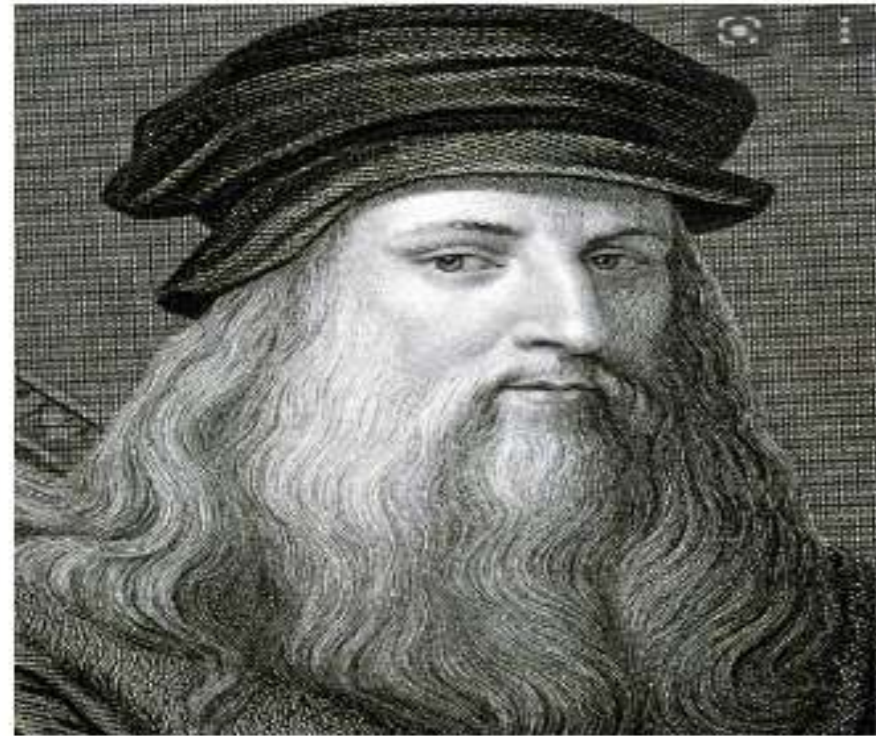
I use the **comparative of inferiority**:

Examples: Clock Tower is **not as** high **as** Eiffel Tower. (≠)

Comparative Adjectives

a - e - i - o - u

To compare two persons, objects or animals, I use adjectives.

1/ Comparative Adjectives can be **Short** (= 1 or ~~2~~ syllables).

Examples: - **Big**/**Tall**/**Cold**/**Hot** - (one syllable)
- ~~Happy~~/~~Easy~~/~~Funny~~ (two syllable)

2/ Comparative Adjectives can be **Long** (= + 2 syllables).

Examples: - **Dangerous**/**Important**/**Expansive**

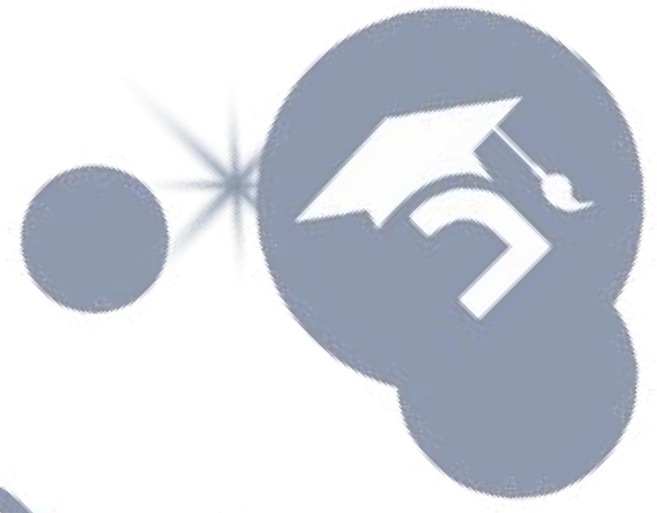

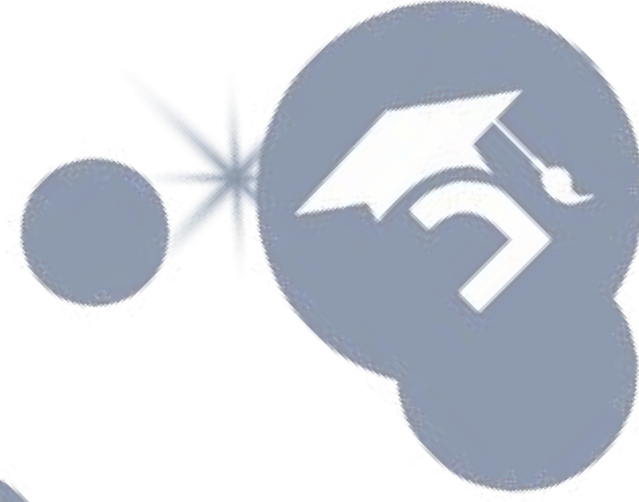

Comparative Adjectives: Spelling Rules

① **RULE 1:** Drop the final "e" in the Short Adjectives.

Examples: - Rareer/ Largeer/ Niceer

② **RULE 2:** Change the final "y" into "i" in the Short Adjectives with two syllables.

Examples: - Easy → Easier/ Happy → Happier/ Funny

Funny → Funnier
(two syllables)

Shy → shyier
(one syllable)

③ **Rule 3:** Short adjectives ending in (VC)
Big → Bigger

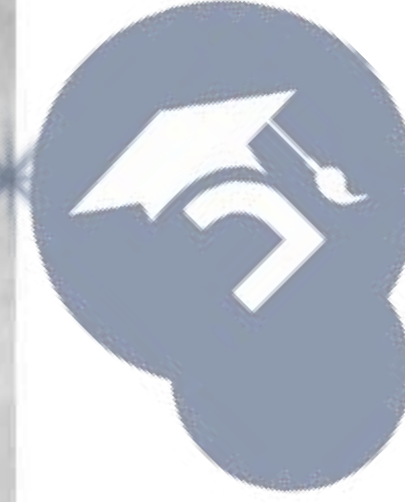

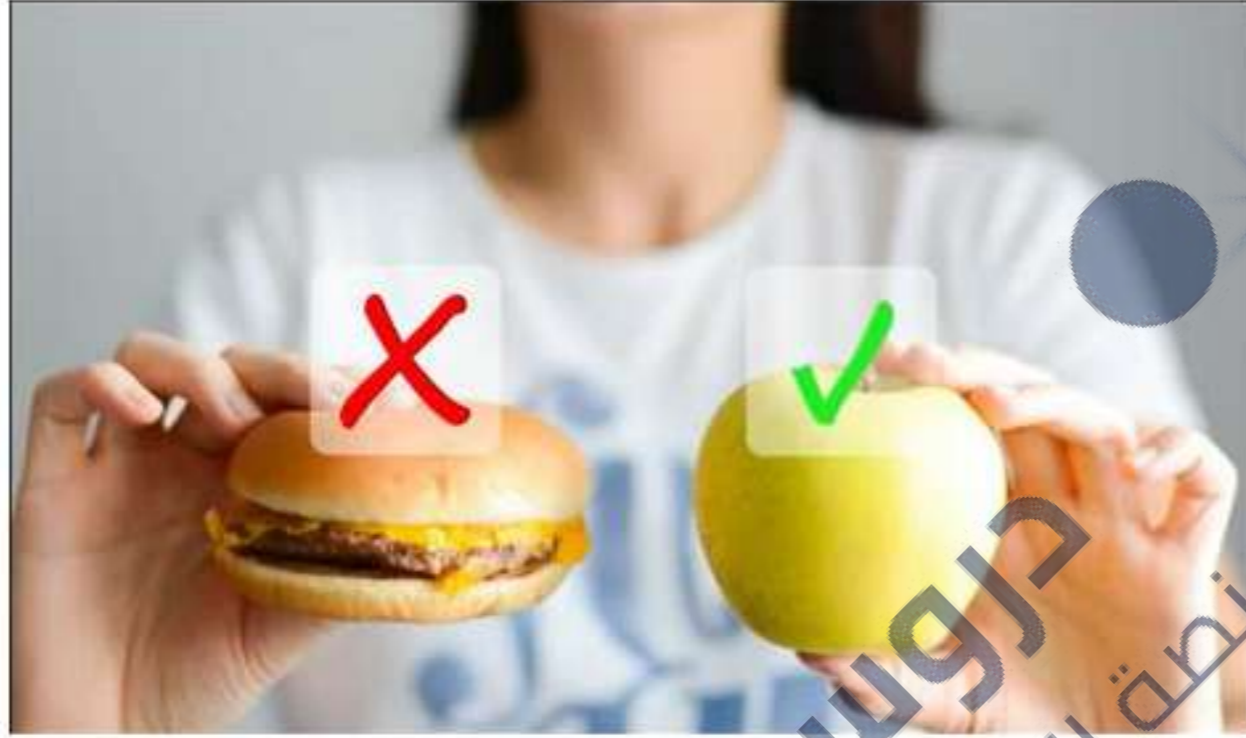

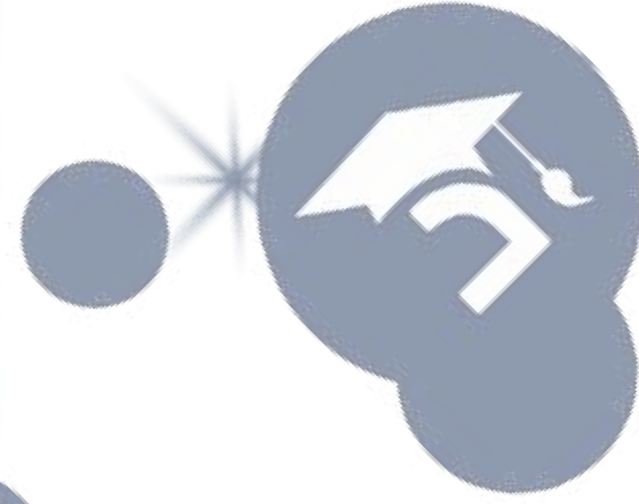

Larbi Ben Mhidi is a prominent figure in Algeria's history and its long struggle for independence. He was born in 1923 in Ain Mhila, ~~Algeria~~. He was a revolutionary leader and a freedom fighter. 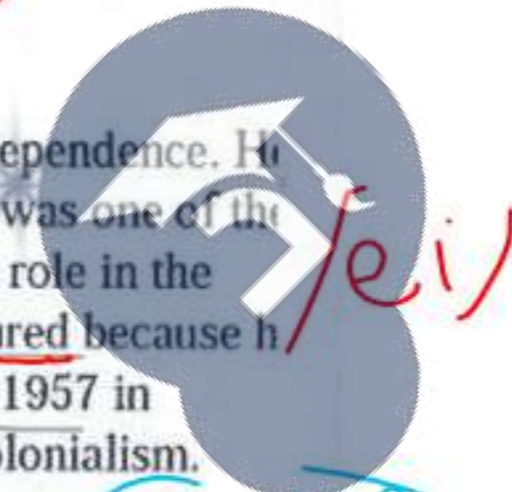

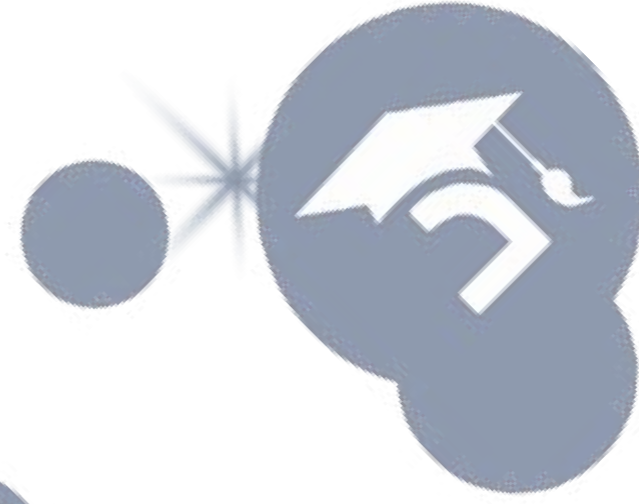

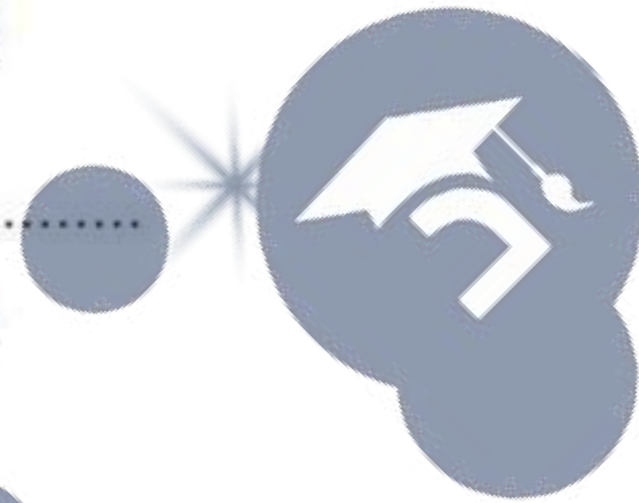
