corruption, citizens will elect him again.

We can link between the two pairs using whether if in type 01 or using "provided that- providing that- as long as- so long as- but only if"

Lesson01: Expressing condition

If conditional type 01

If+ Present Simple, Future Simple
Future simple + If+ Present Simple

Providing that

Provided that

As long as

But only if

Ex: Providing that you work hard, you will succeed.

Providing that + Present simple , future simple

Subordinate clause , main clause

You will succeed **providing that** you work hard.

future simple + Providing that + Present simple

We can say:

If you **revise** all the lessons, you **will pass** the exams easily.

You **will pass** the exams easily if you **revise** all the lessons.

N.B: provided that – providing that – as long as- so long as – but only if **function as same as if in type 01.**

Also they can be placed whether at the beginning of the sentence as well as in the middle the most important thing is that they must be linked **with the subordinate clause** \Rightarrow Ask which is **the first action.**
